Class N and N+ Permits offer flexible parking in the evenings, giving you access to plenty of spaces near campus buildings. This enhances your safety by reducing long walks and keeping you near well-lit areas. These permits are valid for street and surface lot parking in spaces that open up to "Any UT Permit" weekdays 5:45 p.m.-7:30 a.m. For added convenience, N+ permits also allow parking in most garages across campus weekdays 5 p.m.-4 a.m.
